Harold "Hal" V. Turngren, 75, of Mahomet, formerly of Hoopeston, passed away at 5:45 a.m. Thursday, January 14, 2016, at Presence Covenant Medical Center in Urbana.

Hal was born on October 16, 1940, in Harvey, Illinois, the son of Arthur and Gail (Bailey) Turngren. He married JoAnn Pajor on November 23, 1963, in Harvey, Illinois. She preceded him in death on September 21, 1998. He then married Shirley Yoder on June 2, 2001, at Kennekuk Park in Danville. She survives.
