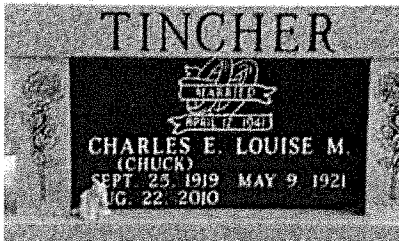
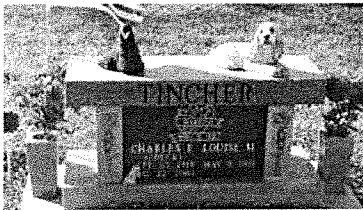

He was born Sept. 25, 1919 in Watseka to Francis M. and Nora M. Groves Tincher. He married Louise M. Milar on April 12, 1941 in Sheldon. She survives.
