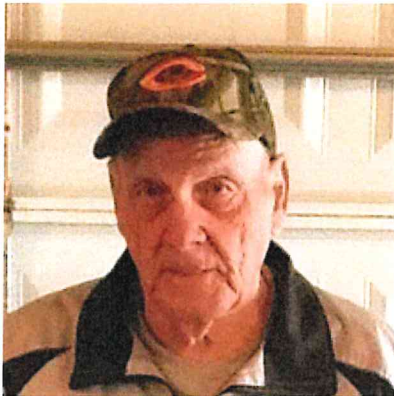


James Edward Farney

James Edward Farney, 81, of Hoopeston, passed away at 11:33 a.m. Thursday, November 17, 2016, at his son's home in Hebron, Indiana.
