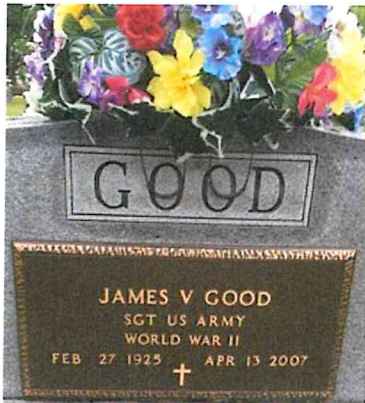

James "Jim" V. Good, 82, of Hoopeston died at 5:55 a.m. Friday, April 13, 2007 at the Hoopeston Community Memorial Nursing Home.
