Charles Harold "Cooger" "Shorty" Lane, 77, of Hoopeston, Ill., died at 8:38 a.m. Tuesday, March 20, 2007, in Urbana, Ill. He was the father of a local resident.

Born May 23, 1929, in Hoopeston, he was the son of the late Clarence Harold Lane and Clara Viola Goodpaster.

Mr. Lane served in the Army Air Force from December 1947 to June 20, 1950 as a cook.
