HOOPESTON --- Wilbur Carl "Wib" Longfellow Sr., 88, of 319 W. Penn St. Died at 11 p.m. Wednesday, January 31, 1990 at Hoopeston Community Memorial Hospital, following a lengthy illness.

He was born Tuesday, April 16, 1901, in Hoopeston, the son of Isaac and Ella Waugh Longfellow. He married Elsie Louise Silvers on Saturday, September 9, 1922 in Hoopeston, Illinois.
