Eugene Elmer Malady, 94, of Hoopeston died at 8:11 p.m. Wednesday, Oct. 17, 2007, at the Hoopeston Community Memorial Hospital.

Born March 24, 1913, in Vermilion County on a farm near the Indiana state line, he was the son of Thomas and Alice (Blessing) Malady. He married Elizabeth Jennett on April 11, 1953, at Hoopeston. She survives.
