

Frances Ione Brown McCrory, 84, of Hoopeston Illinois, died Wednesday, July 13, 2005, at Hoopeston Community Memorial Nursing Home.

Mrs. McCrory was born June 25, 1921, in Danville,Illinois a daughter of Glenn and Hazel McBride Brown. She married Robert L. McCrory on Oct. 8, 1942, in St. Louis. He died July 30, 1970.
