Joseph J. Haggerty Sr., 75, of Hoopeston was born into eternal life at 5:05 p.m. Sunday, Jan. 7, 2008.

He was the son of Richard Edward and Alice Catherine (Cunningham)
Haggerty Sr. He married Janet Marilyn Hatfield on Jan. 10, 1959, at Chicago.
She survives.

He was preceded in death by a son, Patrick Gerard; a daughter, Karen Anne; his parents; three brothers; and four sisters.

Joe was born Oct. 5, 1932, and reared in the Beverly Hills area of Chicago, one of 12 children in his family. He graduated from Morgan Park High School in 1951 and received his philosophy of commerce degree from the University of Notre Dame in 1955. He earned his pilot's license while serving as a corpsman with the U.S. Navy for two years following college graduation.

Following his service in the U.S. Navy, he and his family owned and operated Haggerty Oil Company in Chicago. He later was employed by the General

Motors Corp. in the Chicago, Peoria and Green Bay zones from 1960 to 1970, working as a district manager, service manager and assistant sales promotion manager. From 1970 to 1980 he owned and operated Joe Haggerty Chevy-Olds Inc., Hoopeston. He owned and operated a snack-vending business from 1980 to 1990 and was owner-operator of Haggerty Trucking until his retirement in 2004.

Joe was an active member of St. Anthony's Catholic Church, Hoopeston, and served in various capacities in automotive organizations. His hobbies included golf, bowling, reading, political debate and enjoying his wonderful children and grandchildren.
