

Mary K. Metzinger, 95, died at 2:30 p.m. Sunday in her home at County Line Road, Route 1, Otterbein.

Born Oct. 7, 1890, in Allerton, Illinois, she was reared there.

In 1910 she was married in Danville, Illinois, to Ralph Cline. They lived in Sidell, Illinois, where they were engaged in farming. He died in 1918.

She moved with her parents to Ambia, and worked several years in a bank there.

In 1924 she was married in Hoopeston, Illinois, to George Metzinger. They farmed near Ambia, and in 1943 moved to the Otterbein community. They retired and moved to the town of Otterbein in 1958. Mr. Metzinger died in 1971.

Mrs. Metzinger was a housemother at St. Elizabeth School of Nursing in Lafayette several years.

She was a member of St. Charles Catholic Church in Otterbein and St. Charles Rosary Society.

Surviving are three daughters, Pauline Kincaid of Newman, Illinois, Clara L. Finch of Lafayette, and Evelyn Johnson of Route 2, Otterbein; one son, Robert Cline of Edwardsburg, Mich.; and a sister, Julia Gurley of Otterbein.
