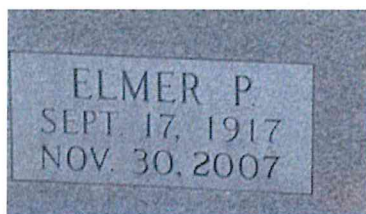

Elmer Paul Unger, 90, of Hoopeston, died at 9:40 p.m. Friday, Nov. 30, 2007.

He was born Sept. 17, 1917, in the Plainview neighborhood southwest of Hoopeston, the son of George Earl and Eva Lena (Gladding) Unger.

He graduated from John Greer High School in 1936 and went into farming with his father and brother. He farmed for 43 years.

He married Barbara Ault in 1939. They were the parents of four children: Sandra Lee Malone of Irvine, Calif., Elmer Paul (Judith) of Savoy, Stephen Allen (Marilyn) of Hoopeston and Sue Ellen (Richard) Williamson of the Prairie Green neighborhood.
