



Charles Ross Moore, 50, of Oak Park and River Forest, died June 7 in Oak Park Hospital.

Mr. Moore was born Jan. 20, 1947 in St. Louis, Missouri to Maxine, nee Marrs, and Harold M. Moore. At the age of 1, his family moved to Oak Park where he resided all of his life until 1992 when he and his wife and children moved to River Forest.
