- This permit may be used for transportation by common carrier.

Signature

 All permits must be endorsed by the sexton, recorded in the sexton's register, and forwarded within five days of disposition to the local registrar or designee.

This final disposition permit, when completed and bearing the required signature, constitues authority for burial, interment, cremation, removal from state, or other authorized disposition of deceased named below, in accordance with Section 25-2-111 C.R.S. 1982. This

permit must accompany the remains to thier final destination.
