

AUTHORITY FOR FINAL DISPOSITION

COLORADO DEPARTMENT OF PUBLIC HEALTH AND ENVIRONMENT

READ CAREFULLY

- It is unlawful for any person in charge of a burial place or crematory to permit burial or other disposition of a dead human body or fetus until a final disposition has been issued.
- A final disposition permit may be issued only upon registration of a death certificate.
- A final disposition permit is required for any type of disposition of a dead human body or fetus.
- This permit may be used for transportation by common carrier.
- All permits must be endorsed by the sexton, recorded in the sexton's register, and forwarded within five days of disposition to the local registrar or designee.

This final disposition permit, when completed and bearing the required signature, constitutes authority for burial, interment, cremation, removal from state, or other authorized disposition of deceased named below, in accordance with Section 25-2-111 C.R.S. 1982. This permit must accompany the remains to their final destination.
