HOOPESTON, III. -- Earl Longfellow, 90, of 859 E: Young Ave., died at 7:30 a.m. Friday (August 22, 1986) at the home of his daughter, Maurine Longfellow (Mrs. Willard) Bruens.

He had farmed for 53 years and was a member of Company B of Hoopeston during World War I. He was a member of the Ira Owen Kreager Post 384 American Legion.

Born March 1, 1896 at Hoopeston, he was the son of Isaac and Ellen Gertrude "Ella" Waugh Longfellow. He married Lota Jane Wagoner on June 16, 1919. She preceded him in death on October 5, 1969.

Survivors include six sons, Earl J.
