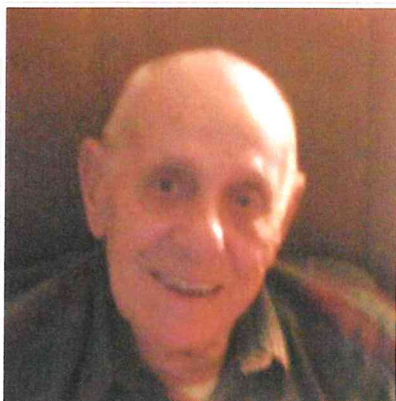


Marvin L. Buhrmester
