

Preston L. Hedgecock, 78, of Potomac, died Saturday, Feb. 9 at his home following a sudden illness.

Born Sept. 3, 1905 in Wellington, he was the son of Lawrence and Mabel Mobley Hedgecock.

On Feb. 5, 1926 he married the former Laura B. Holcutt, who survives. Before retiring in 1965, he was employed for 37 years by John Deere Ironworks, Hoopeston. For a number of years, Mr. Hedgecock and his wife, were custodians of the Vermillion Fishing Club near Danville. They moved from Hoopeston to Potomac in 1968.
