

Charles Wayne Irvin, 76, of Lake Alfred, Fla., formerly of Wellington, died at 11:55 a.m. Sunday, March 2, 2008, at his residence.

He was born Feb. 23, 1932, in Rankin, the son of Harry Irvin and Edna Fisher Irvin. He married Norma Totheroh Dec. 30, 1955, at the Prairie Green Church of Christ in Wellington. She survives in Wellington.
