Marvel Elaine (Gray) Norton, 94, of Hoopeston, passed away at 8:25 a.m. Tuesday, April 12, 2011, at her home in Hoopeston.

Marvel was born Oct. 15, 1916, in Penfield, daughter of Eldon Gray and Nina E. (Rader) Gray.

She attended Rossville schools and graduated from Rossville High School in 1934.

She married Colmon W. Norton in 1942 in Hoopeston. He preceded her in death in 1993.
