Olga Gregoria McLane, 89, of Danville, passed away at 5 a.m. Wednesday, June 25, 2008, at the Carle Foundation Hospital in Urbana.

She was born May 25, 1919, in Hiroshima, Japan, the daughter of Sebastian Rufus and Mercedes Maria Coelho De Jose. Both deceased.

On Jan. 4, 1947, Olga married Mr. William E. 'Mac' McLane during WW II while both were working to restore communications in China after the war. He preceded her in death Nov. 11, 1974. Olga is survived and will be missed by her four children: Cheryl Palandro (Fred Baus) of New Jersey, Kathy Read of Champaign, Ray (Barbara) McLane of Ohio and Edward McLane. Three grandchildren: Vincent Palandro, April McLane, Valerie McLane; her great-grandson: Ramon McLane; and her brother, Albert of Hong Kong.

Olga loved her faith as a Jehovah's Witness, working in her vegetable and flower gardens, and making crafts. Olga had an extraordinary life from early childhood through her experience in China during WW II, to present day. Her life journey culminated in a woman who remained resilient, strong in character, and devoted to her faith.
