Robert Lee Kincade, 89, of Williamsport, IN, passed away at 8:17 A.M. Sunday April 16, 2017 at Parkview Healthcare in Attica, IN. He was born January 30, 1928, in Heidrick, IN, the son of Lawrence and Monzell (England) Kincade.

He married LaVonne Barker on November 28, 1946 and she preceded him in death on June 12, 1967.
